### **TUITION POLICY**

Yearly tuition can be made in monthly payments September through May. Tuition payments are due the first lesson of each month. We accept cash, check or charge. Auto pay can be set up thru your parent portal and is run on the 5th of every month. This is an easy way to make sure your payment is on time. A late fee of \$20 is added to any balance on your account that is not paid by the 15th starting in October. If yearly tuition is paid IN FULL by September 30, 2020 you will receive 2 free tickets to our annual recital in June.

### **DRESS CODE**

Leotard and tights are required for every class. Please make sure you have the proper shoes for each class. Our Dancewear Shoppe carries all you need and more. We will make sure you have the right shoe and size for your feet. Never wear your dance shoes outside and remember that shorts are NOT allowed in combo class or ballet classes. (Does not apply to boys) As the weather turns cooler, please have your dancer wear clothes over the leotard and tights.
